

Council for Quality sets up online tool for improvement

The Minnesota Council for Quality has launched a one-stop online resource for organizations looking for information on how to improve their performance, effectiveness, and results.

The Improvement Clearinghouse offers hundreds of articles, benchmarking resources, event notices, Web links, and white papers on a wide range of organizational improvement topics.

A directory of improvement vendors, including coaches, facilitators, and trainers, will be added by fall, said Brian Lassiter, president of the Minneapolis-based nonprofit council.

“There are too many sources of information,” Lassiter said, adding that the clearinghouse aims to provide a single, cost-effective way for organizations to obtain improvement information. The site is geared mainly to small businesses, non-profits, schools and public agencies, he said.
