MINNESOTA COUNCIL FOR QUALITY ELECTS TODD BILLE TO BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The Minnesota Council for Quality recently announced the election of Todd Bille to their Board of Directors. Mr. Bille is currently a Strategic and Operational Planning Specialist in the Department of Planning Services at the Mayo Clinic in Rochester. Mr. Bille is also the Chair of the Rochester Area Quality Council (RAQC).

Approved unanimously, the decision to make this Board seat an ex Officio position for the current incumbent Chair of the RAQC was significant.
